Sing a song with rhyming words, such as "Do Your Ears Hang Low?"



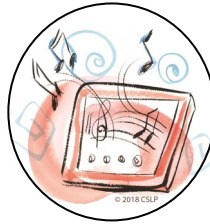
Read a story about a famous musician.

Talk about the various sounds you hear as you go about your day.

Go on a shape hunt while shopping together. How many triangles can you find?
