Read to your child!

- Register & log online or through the free **Beanstack app**.
- Earn **Logging Badges, Big Beads**, and a **free book** as you read to your child. *(Yes, if you read it again, count it again. Story Time books count too! Log the books read by anyone, anywhere. Titles are optional.)*
- Earn **Activity Badges** as you learn more about early literacy. Visit the library to collect **Rhyme Cards**. Expect to read, sing, talk, play, and “write” with your child.
- Preschoolers can make a **Big Bead Reading Necklace**.
- Earn any 10 badges for a **Summer Reading Certificate** and **Bubbles**.
- Every badge earns online tickets for **Grand Prizes** such as a Bubble machine kit, gift basket, keyboard, & more.

Online registration is open.

Reading starts the day after Memorial Day.

Prize Pick up starts the first Monday in June.

Prize pick-up closes at 8p.m. the last Wednesday in July. Logging & online ticket entry ends at midnight.
